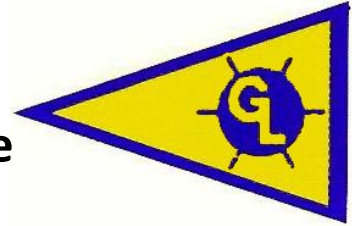
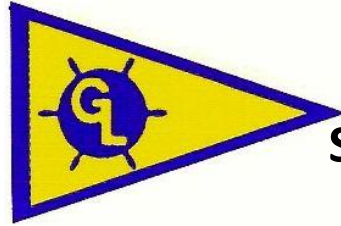

Supplemental Notice of Race

Saturday June 27, 2026



- 1) **Rules and Management:** Great Lakes Yacht Club (GLYC) is the Organizing Authority (OA) for the GLYC Summer Regatta. This race will be governed by the DRYA Notice of Race (NOR) and Sailing Instructions (SI) and the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2025-2028 (RRS), or as amended herein.
- 2) This race is a DRYA counter race. The race is open to all boats registered for DRYA Counter Series races.
 - a) This race is the second of two regattas in one weekend, for the **NEW 9 Mile Trophy**. The other regatta is LSSC's Friday Night Lights. The trophy will be awarded at the end of the season DRYA awards evening, to the boat with the fastest seconds per mile average for the two regattas.
 - b) Invited boats not registered to race with DRYA but wishing to race in a DRYA class may register for this race by filling out the application form, found on the DRYA website drya.org, and paying the \$50 registration fee. Boats must meet the class criteria as set forth by the DRYA for 2026. Registrations must be submitted to DRYA by 7:00pm Wednesday June 24, 2026, at drya.org
- 3) **Club JAM:** We invite all boats not racing in the DRYA series to submit an application to GLYC by 7:00pm, June 24, 2026, to be an **invited boat** and race in the "Club JAM" (Jib & Main) class. The application form can be found at greatlakesyc.com/summer-regatta. **NOTE: You must also submit a registration form to DRYA** ([click to see the instructions](#)). Registration fee is \$50; Invited GLYC members: No charge and your boat's most recent MWPFRF Handicap from the last three (3) years will be used, or the GLYC Race Committee will provide one. - 4) The GLYC Summer Regatta is a standard DRYA Windward-Leeward (W/L) Regatta. Be sure to read the DRYA Notice of Race (NOR) and the DRYA Sailing Instructions (SIs) as they govern this regatta unless modified by the GLYC SNOR or SSIs. Be sure to review the GLYC Supplemental Sailing Instructions (SSIs) for those modifications to these standard instructions. NOTE: Where any conflicts arise between the race documents the GLYC SSI will govern.

- 5) The Classes and Class Splits will follow the DRYA Saturday Windward-Leeward Class Splits and Starts. Please refer to the DRYA NOR/Sl.
- 6) **Counter Series Boats:** All boats racing in a DRYA Class must have a valid 2026 MWPHRF or ORC Certificate. To get a MWPHRF or ORC handicap to go: <https://www.mwphrf.org> or www.ussail.org.
- 7) **Schedule of Events:**
 - a) **Wednesday June 24, 2026, 7:00pm** is the deadline for registration of Invited Boats, (those not previously registered with DRYA).
 - b) **Saturday June 27, 2026:** First warning at 10:30 am on the Windward-Leeward Course. See the DRYA SI for the course location and order of starts.
- 8) **Awards: There will be an Awards ceremony after the race at the GLYC clubhouse.** Results will also be posted at greatlakesyc.com and DRYA.org under "Schedule and Results".
 - a) Approximate awards party start is 3:30 pm.
 - b) Food will be available for purchase in the GLYC galley – credit cards only.
 - c) 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place Flags will be presented for every Class.
 - d) Results for new, 9 Mile Trophy will also be announced.
- 9) **Free Berthing:** Boats participating in LSSC's Friday Night Lights Regatta may stay at great Lakes Yacht Club Friday evening for free. Arrangements must be made in advance by contacting LSSC's Vice Commodore Andrew Schultz, at ViceCommodoreLSSC@gmail.com.
